

Industry & Government Engagement Sub-Committee

Terms of Reference

Purpose

The Institute's Membership Committee establishes the Industry & Government Engagement Sub-Committee.

The Institute's Industry and Government Engagement Sub-Committee is responsible for obtaining industry advice on the changing professional requirements of management accountants and business analysts. This responsibility extends to engaging with industry and government to ascertain their needs in terms of: (1) employment trends; (2) professional competencies; and (3) skill requirements in terms of migration. Industry advice will extend to providing advice to the Sub-Committees of the Education Committee related to the development of the curriculum of courses in the Institute's professional education programs and the proposed academic programs. The Industry and Government Engagement Sub-Committee is responsible for recognising new trends in the education sector that could lead to new professional credentials being developed by the Institute. It is also responsible for liaising with universities in developing strategic alliances for research, education and training, and the Emerging Professional Scholarship scheme.

Membership & Appointment

- 1. Up to five members who:
 - are members of the institute, and;
 - have an interest in management accounting education and its relationship with the countries that ICMA operates in, and;
 - bring special skills relevant to the strategic direction of the branches and the institute
- 2. In Attendance: Executive Director (or nominee)

Membership of the IGESC is by invitation of the CEO and for a term of five years.

Meetings

The IGESC will meet at least twice a year.

The meeting dates and agenda are to be approved by both the Convenor/Chair prior to meeting.

The Convenor/Chair of the IGESC will meet with the members of the ICMA MC and other committees at a minimum six monthly.

Reporting

The IGESC provides advice to the EC on at least a six-monthly basis regarding key issues raised by the MC.



A report prepared by the IGESC is to be developed for discussion and included in the MC report which will be presented at the AGM. The report will outline the activities and contribution of the IGESC. These reports are presented at the AGM of ICMA for noting and/or action as appropriate.
